


If a product must be returned for any reason, please contact our Customer Service Department to obtain a Returned Material Authorization number (RMA#) before you ship the product back.

Please write the RMA # clearly on the package near the mailing label.






- Route the wires through the center of the gasket and align the bolts properly BEFORE REMOVING THE BACKING.
- 5. Remove the adhesive backing on the gasket and carefully stick the gasket onto the base, over the bolts, with the wires routed through the center hole.
- Route your wires through the mounting surface if applicable.



7. Install your light with the four bolts going through your mounting holes. Place a washer and nut on each of the bolts and tighten until snug.

Wiring

CAUTION: All of our DC powered warning lights are polarity sensitive. These lights are polarity protected *only if the appropriate fuse* is used. All wires connected to the positive terminal of the battery should be fused <u>at the battery</u> for their rated load. **Testing the light before this fuse is properly installed will void the warranty on the light.**



Black - (Ground) Connect to the negative side of the battery.

Red - (Power) Connect to +12 VDC through an ignition switched source. This connection is mandatory. Be sure to use a 20 amp fuse when connecting to the positive side of the power supply.

Please Note: When the red wire is connected to +12VDC the pack will draw a small current (50 mA). If your vehicle will be sitting for extended periods of time (i.e. more than a few days), it is recommended the red wire be routed through a switch or ignition switched relay.

Orange w/Red - (Enable Color 1) Connect to +12 VDC to activate the primary color.

White w/Brown - (Enable Color 2) Connect to +12 VDC to activate the secondary color.

Green w/Yellow - (Optional - High/Low) Switches the light between High and Low power.

- High Power Only: Leave disconnected (cover with wire nut or tape)
- Low Power Only: Connect to +12VDC
- High/Low Switching Option: Connect to +12VDC through a switch

Red w/Green - (Pattern Select) Touch and release to +12 VDC to change patterns (see next page).



Pattern Programming

- To change patterns, briefly touch and release the Red w/Green Stripe wire to +12 VDC.
- The cycle repeats after the last pattern.
- Pattern Shortcuts: Touch and hold the Red w/Green Stripe Wire to +12 VDC for the length of
 time that corresponds to the pattern you would like to jump to. Once you find the pattern you
 wish to display, connect the Pattern Select wire to ground and deactivate the light. This will
 store the selected pattern.
